TEST SERIES RULES

1. Have all your stationery with you e.g. pen, pencil, eraser, ruler, calculator, stapler etc in a clear, see through pencil bag or plastic sleeve. No borrowing allowed. Paper will be provided.
2. Check your timetable carefully so you know when you are writing. Homework will not be given on the night prior to the test written during the Test Series.
3. All examinations or tests to be written in black or blue ink only. Diagrams may be done in pencil.
4. Write your name and grade at the top of each page.
5. Read your questions carefully. Watch the time. Turn over your question paper to ensure that you do not miss any questions on the back of the paper.
6. You may not hand in your test paper when you have finished: check your work and stay seated. You may not draw, sleep or read when you have finished your test.
7. No communication, verbal or non-verbal, with fellow learners must occur.
8. No correction fluid e.g. Tippex allowed. Cross out your mistake and write over neatly.
9. The group coming in to write their test will report at the Thorp Hall for screening. After screening they line up in alphabetical order in their register classes outside their venue.
10. Group 1 (all classes) will write in the Blake Hall and Group 2 (all classes) will write in the Thorp Hall. On days that you are at school, the teacher in charge of the class in the last lesson, will accompany you to your venue.
11. Tests will finish at 15h00 and learners can be fetched from the Thorp Hall entrance. Learners having to wait for transport must please do so in front of the school as it is a safer option.
12. A medical certificate is required if you are absent for a test during the Test Series.
13. You wear your full school uniform as usual.
