GRADE 10 FINAL EXAMINATION NOTES - 2020

Preparation for examinations:

- ⇒ Timetables issued and available on school's website
- ⇒ Check all subjects and papers carefully

Dress code:

- ⇒ Conservative civvies may be worn
- ⇒ Wear masks properly at all times, to cover mouth and nose (legal requirement)
- ⇒ No caps, hats, beanies, scarves, blankets, etc. allowed in the examination venue

Before start of examination session:

- ⇒ Arrive at 7:50 (normal starting time for school) for 1st session
- ⇒ Arrive at 12:20 for 2nd session
- ⇒ All candidates must be screened (7:50 – 8:10 for 1st session and 12:20 – 12:40 for 2nd session)
- ⇒ After screening has taken place, candidates must identify their seat numbers, after which they may use the bathroom, hand in textbooks or wait in quad until it is time to be seated. Please do not wait outside school premises or in cars until the last possible moment!
- ⇒ Candidates are to be seated 15 minutes before start of an examination
- ⇒ The door will be locked at this point
- ⇒ Any candidate arriving after this will only be allowed into the venue once all preparations in the examination venue have been completed
- ⇒ No additional time will be allowed in this case
- ⇒ 8:15/12:45: Seated in venue
- ⇒ 8:20/12:50: Examination papers distributed and checked
- ⇒ 8:20 – 8:30/12:50 – 13:00: Reading time
- ⇒ 8:30/13:00: Start of examination
- ⇒ Should a candidate miss an examination due to illness, a valid doctor's certificate must be given/sent to Mr Ferreira asap (preferably on the day of the missed examination)

During examination session:

- ⇒ No talking is allowed from the moment candidates enter the examination venue
- ⇒ No borrowing is allowed. Bring own supplies in a CLEAR plastic bag

- ⇒ Only a blue or black pen may be used. No colour and highlighting to be used on answer script.
- ⇒ Tippex is not allowed. Merely cross out incorrect work
- ⇒ No food or water/cold drink may be allowed in the examination venue
- ⇒ **Cell phones/smart watches may not be brought into the examination venue. If found on the candidate, this will be treated as an irregularity and the device will be confiscated (whether used or not) and handed in at the office along with the examination paper of the candidate**
- ⇒ **Do not cheat. This is an irregularity and will result in the relevant examination to be declared null and void for the candidate concerned**
- ⇒ The venue may not be left within the first hour of the examination or the last 15 minutes of the examination.
- ⇒ Should a candidate require a bathroom break, he/she will be accompanied by an invigilator of the same gender
- ⇒ On return from the bathroom, invigilator and candidate must sanitise their hands
- ⇒ Candidates may not ask any questions or be helped by invigilators in any way, even if they believe there is a problem in the question paper
- ⇒ All answers, rough work, calculations, etc. must be done on the examination answer script. No loose sheets of paper may be attached to the answer script
- ⇒ Candidates may not put their head on the table – sit upright at all times

At the end of the examination session:

- ⇒ Pens down immediately
- ⇒ Check that all details on answer script are correct
- ⇒ No candidate may leave the examination venue until all answer scripts have been collected
- ⇒ Remain silent and seated while invigilators collect materials
- ⇒ Leave the premises via the vehicle entrance in 1st Avenue
- ⇒ You may not re-enter a venue for any reason
