This is to inform you that the GET Phase (Grade 8 and Grade 9) learners will be writing a Controlled Test Series which will start and end on the following dates respectively:

Grade 8: Friday, 23 February - Monday, 12 March.

Grade 9: Monday, 26 February – Wednesday, 13 March.

The grade 8s and grade 9s will write on alternate days in the Thorp Halls and Auditorium, starting at 08H00 and ending at 09H00. The learners will thereafter attend classes for the rest of the academic day.

The purpose of the Test Series is twofold in that it allows for standardised tests to be written timeously, and at the same time to spread the number of tests. Pupils will write an hourlong Controlled Test every second day in certain Learning Areas. The school day will continue as normal after the test has been written and no homework will be given to learners on the days before tests are written. The results of the Test Series will form a large percentage of the marks that will appear on the end of term report for Term One.

It is imperative that learners are not absent from any examination. If a learner is absent, a valid doctor's certificate must be handed in to the Subject Teacher upon return to the school.

We trust that all parents will encourage their children to give their best during the Test Series.
