

Sport awards criteria

Achievement awards (SPORT)

All nominations and awards are carefully considered by the colours committee based on its merits.

Level 1 (SCROLL):

A scroll will be awarded to any player who has participated in at least 80% of the 1st team matches. Junior players (grade 8 and 9) who represent regional teams will be awarded a scroll.

Level 2 (HALF COLOURS - SCROLL AND TIE):

Senior players (grade 10,11 and 12) who are selected to represent regional "B" teams or who, in the opinion of the "Colours Committee", are of provincial standard will be awarded with half colours.

Level 3 (FULL COLOURS - SCROLL, TIE AND BRAID ON BLAZER):

Full colours will be awarded to senior players (grade 10,11 and 12) who represent a regional "A" team or a regional "B" team for two consecutive years or who, in the opinion of the "Colours Committee", are of provincial standard.

Level 4 (HONOURS - SPECIAL BLAZER):

Honours will be awarded to any senior player (grade 10, 11 and 12) who has represented any national team or who achieves on a national level. Each case to be viewed on its own merits.

PLEASE NOTE

The above criteria shall apply to school sport only.

- Players who achieve similar achievements in non-school sports will receive special awards from the school, but not Colours or Honours.
- The Colours Committee may decline to award FULL COLOURS/HONOURS to a learner whose general conduct and record of behaviour is likely to bring the school into disrepute.
